The right candidate for this position will be enrolled in the third or fourth year of an accredited bachelor's degree program, or recently graduated from a higher education institution. While experience in data analysis, economics, and similar degree programs is helpful, it's far more important for the candidate to possess a broad curiosity, be willing to ask insightful and deep questions. Much of our work involves distilling complex information into meaningful intelligence for the Greater Grand Rapids Business community. Writing and communication skills are as important as technical expertise. This position reports to The Right Place's senior vice president of Strategic Initiatives.

Responsibilities

- Research: Research tasks will involve querying variety of public and private databases including the U.S.
 Census Bureau, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Bureau of Economic Analysis, Lightcast, SalesForce, and other
 sources. Research will also include reading and deep analysis of white papers, industry reports, and
 similar resources.
- Analysis: The BI Intern will have access to tools including Excel, PowerBI, Tableau, and others to uncover
 and analyze data trends. As the Business Intelligence team is housed under Strategic Initiatives, a sizeable
 amount of our work also involves combing analytical and strategic thinking skills to build and design
 strategic frameworks for a variety of RPI initiatives.
- **Communicate:** This position includes assisting in analyzing complex information into readable and digestible intelligence. The BI Intern will take part in drafting written briefs and reports, presentations, and other communication that will be published for internal and external use. Our team also frequently discusses research and projects. Please bring a willingness to engage to this role.
